

Sherwood High School PTSA
General Membership Meeting Minutes
October 15, 2013

Called to order: 7:15 p.m.

September Minutes approved unanimously.

Treasurer's Report: Treasurer, Melody Bell, noted revisions to the budget and informed us that an audit was conducted by PTSA members. Budget was voted upon and passed unanimously.

Principal's Report: Mr. Gregory and Mr. Allrich presented the SIP (School Improvement Plan). Mr. Gregory told the story of how this plan developed and covered topics of Student and Stakeholder Focus, Faculty and Staff Focus, Leadership, Strategic Planning and Process Planning. Mr. Allrich discussed Organizational Performance Results, and Measurement, Analysis, and Knowledge Management.

Mr. Gregory noted that it has been determined that he will be Assistant Principal at Lake Seneca Elementary School during the period of 1/2/2014-2/14/2014 while Mr. Allrich temporarily takes over as principal of Sherwood High School. Mr. Gregory thanked the PTSA for the two Promethean Boards which were made possible through use of PTSA funds and a matching grant.

After Prom: Much discussion was had regarding ways in which to revamp/scale back After Prom. Prom was changed from juniors and seniors to seniors only thus altering the need of the size and scope of this event. Two viable suggestions were to eliminate the decorations and to provide a pancake breakfast. After prom coordinator is needed.

President's Report: PTSA President, Sharon St. Pierre, reported that Every 15 Minutes will be replaced by a Trauma Prevention assembly. There will be a series of three presentations including one program for parents with their students at the April PTSA meeting.

Membership: Currently, we have 389 members of which 17 are staff. Sherwood High School has an estimated 1,750 families.

Committee Reports: Carey Gire was introduced as new volunteer coordinator.

New Business: November meeting will discuss carryover of PTSA funds.
