Called to Order: 7:15 PM

Program: UMMC R. Adam Cowley Shock Trauma Center gave an impactful presentation on the dangers of impaired driving.

Bylaws: Approved unanimously.

After-Prom: Susan and Louise (After-Prom committee), reported the details of the event including how many tickets were sold, which restaurants are supplying food, games and prizes. They also detailed the process to enter and the rules regarding handbags. It was impressed that students were not allowed to bring anything in after the prom, only prior. There were two administrators and two security guards monitoring the event.

Prom Buses: Four buses seating forty-seven students each will depart from Longwood Rec. Center at 7:00 and return from the Baltimore Aquarium at 1:00 AM. Students are responsible for themselves. They must get themselves to the bus on time to make a timely departure and arrival.

Graduation Buses: There will be four buses which seat fifty-six passengers each. Seventy tickets have been sold thus far.

President's Report: We are still in need of a 1st Vice President and a 4th Vice President for the 2014/2015 school year. 1st Vice President is responsible for the logistics of the PTSA programs and Staff Appreciation. 4th Vice President oversees the directory and volunteer coordinator.

Treasurer's Report: The treasurer reported on donations of \$700.00 for After-Prom as well as disbursements for Eyre buses, After-Prom, Staff Appreciation and Scholarships.

March minutes approved unanimously.

Principal's Report: Mr. Gregory stated that on April 28, 2014, Superintendent Joshua Starr will be having a Community Day in the Northeast Consortium, Col. Zadok Magruder and Sherwood clusters. Dr. Starr will hold a Town Hall meeting at Paint Branch High School from 7:30-9:00

p.m. that same evening. Mr. Gregory also gave an update on the press coverage regarding Sherwood High School's temporary Prom ticket shortage.
