Direct Student Support (academic learning)

Please note: There is a difference between attending a meeting and volunteering. For example, a parent who assists with setting-up the PTA meeting (refreshments, agenda, clean-up, etc.) is volunteering. A parent who attends the PTA meeting to receive information is not volunteering but involved in parent engagement to support the school and their child's learning.
