

Sherwood High School Parent Teacher Student Association, Inc. – Addendums to 2017 Bylaws

Addendum #1: Article V – Membership Dues

Section 5: The PTSA president, treasurer, or membership chair may at his/her discretion adjust or waive the local membership dues for any individual or family on a financial need basis. The amounts of national, state, and Montgomery County Council of PTAs dues cannot be waived or reduced.

Addendum #2: Article VI – Officers and Their Election

Section 3e: Rising Freshman parents in good standing with their middle school PT(S)A are eligible for all elected positions without having to officially join SHS PTSA at the end of the school year that elections are held. As with all officers, they must become members of SHS PTSA for the year of their term.

Addendum #3: Article VII – Duties of Officers

Section 2:

- a. 1st VP shall act as an aide to the President and shall perform the duties of president in the absence or inability of the President to serve. Furthermore the 1st VP, in coordination with the President, has primary responsibility to arrange and coordinate programs for PTSA general meetings.
- b. The VP Communications (4th VP) primary responsibility is to coordinate, manage, and oversee communications from the SHS PTSA. These include oversight of the PTSA website, 'On Point' news brief, Twitter account, and serve as a backup to the listserv moderator and the secretary.
- c. The Staff VP (2nd VP) is a teacher at Sherwood HS and represents the teachers of SHS to the PTSA. The Staff VP shall report decisions of the PTSA to staff and bring staff recommendation forward to the executive board or board of directors.
- d. The Student VP (3rd VP) is a Senior at Sherwood HS and represents the students of SHS to the PTSA. The Student VP shall report decisions of the PTSA to staff and bring staff recommendation forward to the executive board or board of directors.

Addendum #4: Article VII – Duties of Officers

Section 8: Immediate Past President –The immediate past president may serve as a member of the executive board and the board of directors. The primary responsibility of the position is to serve in an advisory role. This position is voluntary for the immediate past president.

Addendum #5: Article X - Committees

Section 8: As a standing committee of the SHS PTSA that handles money and confidential information, the Scholarship Committee shall have bylaws that are reviewed and approved as an addendum to the General Bylaws of SHS PTSA. Scholarship Committee Bylaws are attached.
